

Exact Specs/Affordable Computing Warranty

2 years Labor, 1 Years parts plus Manufacturers additional if any.

Exact Specs/Affordable Computing and will be called Exact Specs for ease of use.

EXACT SPECS WILL PERFORM IN-HOME/OFFICE REPAIRS UNDER THE FOLLOWING

LIMITED WARRANTY- Exact Specs provides a 2 year labor and 1 year parts warranty for the quality of all its products. Motherboards, Hard Drives and Processors are covered for additional periods according to the manufacturers warranty.

During this period, Exact Specs will (at our option) repair or replace all merchandise which proves to be defective; however, Exact Specs will not warranty any product which has been subjected to improper freight handling/shipping, abuse, neglect, or unauthorized repair or installation. This does not cover warranty on any parts not authorized by Exact Specs. **Exact Specs is not responsible for any lost data regardless of product defect. It is the users responsibility to maintain a current backup of their system.** Exact Specs also does not accept any responsibility for computer downtime due to repairs, upgrades or anything of that nature. Warranty policy is not extended beyond the original buyer. And home repairs may require shipping at the owners cost if the owner has moved outside Exact Specs service area.

PARTS UNDER FACTORY WARRANTY WILL BE SERVICED BY EXACT SPECS OR THE MANUFACTURER (CUSTOMERS CHOICE) FOR ONE YEAR. ANY SERVICE NEEDED AFTER ONE YEAR MUST BE REFERRED TO THE MANUFACTURERS SERVICE CENTER FOR EXTENDED WARRANTY REPAIRS. ALL WARRANTIES MAYBE VOIDED IF SERVICE IS PERFORMED BY ANYONE EXCEPT THE MANUFACTURER OR EXACT SPECS.

TWO YEAR LABOR TERMS - Covers installation of new hardware upgrades to the system, diagnostics, repairs and/or replacement of defective hardware components. This service covers either in-store or inhome/office labor only and applies only the components with the main unit. This excludes outside peripherals such as monitors, printers, keyboards, mice and others unless purchased from Exact Specs.

There will be additional charges for on-site service and repairs to components that were not purchased from Exact Specs. This warranty does not cover user negligence/damage, special setup of hardware components not originally specified at time of purchase, **software problems** or installation of operating systems not provided with the system. **Exact Specs Computer is not responsible for damage caused by viruses or there removal.** All requests for warranty repairs must be accompanied by original invoice at all times.

SELLER MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR OF MERCHANTABILITY. IN NO EVENT SHALL SELLER BE LIABLE FOR INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES SUCH AS LOSS OF PROFITS OR BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL SELLER'S LIABILITY EXCEED THE PURCHASE PRICE OF THE PRODUCT(S).

In the event of non-payment;

In the event of non-payment ,section 3051, 3052 provides Exact Specs the provision to auction property held for more pursuant to the bellow regulations. This is sighted below.

Section 3051, 3052. **Auction may proceed non-payment in excess of 2 months.**

Sale of property by lien-holder: If the person entitled to the lien provided in Section 3051 is not paid the amount due, and for which such lien is given, within 15 days after the same shall have become due, a certified mail reminder will be sent as a courtesy. If there is no payment within 10 days after receiving confirmation of delivery then Exact Specs/Affordable Computing may proceed to sell such property, or so much thereof as may be necessary to satisfy such lien and costs of sale at public auction, and by giving at least 10 days' but not more than twenty 20 days' previous notice of such sale by advertising in some newspaper published in the county in which such property is situated (The Press Democrat is the locally recognized source for this publication) ; or if there be no newspaper printed in such county, then by posting notice of sale in three of the most public places in the town and at the place where such property is to be sold, for 10 days previous to the date of the sale; provided, however, that within 20 days after such sale, the legal owner may redeem any such property so sold to satisfy such lien upon the payment of the amount thereof, all costs and expenses of such sale, together with interest on such sum at the rate of 12 percent per annum from the due date thereof or the date when the same were advanced until the repayment. The proceeds of the sale must be applied to the discharge of

the lien and the cost of keeping and selling the property. In case of repair, the remainder, if any, must be paid over to the legal owner thereof. In the case of PC sales all proceeds are to be recovered by Exact Specs/Affordable Computing.
